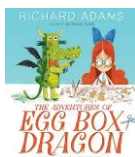


Owls class (y2)

English

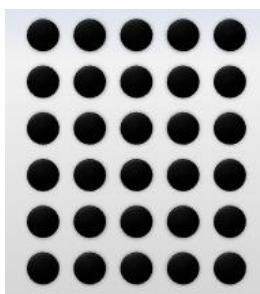

We have specifically been using apostrophes for possession and contractions.



Maths

Multiplication and Division:

Using arrays we have written and solved multiplication and division number sentences and word problems. We finished the week by writing our own word problems such as:



It could be 5 packets of 6 buns!
If Lauren buys 5 packets of buns,
each containing 6 buns how many
does she have altogether?

- **RE** - we have had a special Story Tent week so we have shared RE stories daily. More information is below.
- **Art and DT** - we experimented in mixing colours and then painted these onto pieces of paper which we will use in our collages next week.
- **PSHE** - We are covering 2 topics this term; we looked at increasing independence and medicines.

- **PE** - Swimming, and in cricket we practiced our underarm bowl to try to bowl someone out by hitting the stumps and learnt about the wicket keeper.
