English	Writing creatively about the year - recording a reflection Creating speech bubbles in a comic strip. Spelling: suffix patterns: 'ful' and 'less' Writing an invitation
Maths	Place value Adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers with exchanging Playing 'flip it' maths times table fluency game Counting forward and back in twos from any given number
Other Subjects:	Languages: We listened to a French reading of 'Cher Zoo' and identified many words which are written the same in French as in English - but pronounced with a different accent. PE: athletics and swimming History: Features of a castle and why were they included in the design. Who lived in castles? What were their jobs? RE: The Qur'an - how is it important to Muslims? Art: sketching buildings from the green
