English	<p>Reading - comprehension on animals and lifecycle of a bean</p> <p>Storyboarding the full tale of Pattan's Pumpkin and learning about links to other well known tales.</p> <p>Letter writing - a set of instructions</p> <p>Completing Spelling and Grammar challenges.</p> <p>Friday diary focus on including an opinion in our writing about the Pet Show.</p>
Maths	<p>Data Handling: using and interpreting tallys</p> <p>Creating tables and using results to draw pictograms</p> <p>Drawing and interpreting bar charts.</p> <p>Practical fraction with nature objects</p> <p>Counting forwards and backwards to 100 (securely crossing the tens boundaries)</p>
