English	<p>We have been using some of our English lessons this week to learn some of our new class routines and discuss: different emotions, how they make our bodies react and strategies we can use to help us to regulate our emotions.</p> <p>We read the book 'What we'll build' by Oliver Jeffers to plan the kind of classroom we want and what we can each do individually to make it a happy, calm and successful classroom for everyone.</p> <p>Finally, we used the book 'What a Wonderful World' based on the Louis Armstrong song as a starting point to discuss and write about spirituality as found the extraordinary in the ordinary.</p>
Maths	<p>This week we have been revising and practicing some of the number knowledge that underpins all of our maths.</p> <p>We have looked at:</p> <p>Number bonds to ten and twenty</p> <p>Number fact families - if I know that $6+5=11$ then I also know that $11-6=5$ etc.</p> <p>Times tables.</p> <p>For our times tables we used TTRockstars so all children have logged in and used it to hopefully help them give it a go at home.</p>
