


Robins class (y3)

English	<p>Using our book 'How to Find Gold' by Viviane Schwartz we have looked at using nouns and pronouns for clarity and, after devising both a map and a sea monster, we have produced a narrative about a journey and a character description, using similes, for our sea monster.</p> <p>Spellings: we continued testing the children on the Year 2 words.</p>
Maths	<p>Place Value:</p> <p>This week we have continued to work with numbers up to 1,000. We have been partitioning numbers to 1,000, found 1, 10 and 100 more or less and placed numbers on a number line.</p> <p>Estimate where the numbers belong on the number line.</p> <p>Partition 367 in five different ways. 250 550 850 990</p> <p>Compare answers with a partner.</p> <p>What is the same? What is different? </p>
Other Curriculum Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SCIENCE - We investigated the question - what is a magnet? We have also learnt about magnetic poles. • RE - Our topic this term is People of God. We looked at the story of Noah's Ark to start to understand about how Christians trust in God. • DT - This term we are learning how to sew. We learnt how to do the running stitch. • MUSIC - We practiced B and introduced minims (2 beat notes) alongside crochets (1 beat notes) and we listened to the first section of Vivaldi's recorder concerto. • PE- Basketball - we worked on our dribbling skills and how to keep the ball under control whilst changing direction. • Spanish We are working on greetings. • DRAMA On Thursday, we welcomed Ian from KIC theatre company and we did a workshop on trust to supplement our RE learning. • COMPUTING - As part of our Connecting Computers topic we looked at different input and output devices before having a go at designing our own. • TOPIC - We learnt about grid references.
