## Owls class (y2)

## Friday 6th October 2023: This week we have been... At the beginning of the week, using the book 'The Stone Age Boy', we edited our narrative story where we had become part of the Stone Age. At the end of the week, using the book 'How to wash a woolly mammoth', we planned and wrote our own instructional text. Our spellings this week have all been words ending in -sure Treasure, measure, leisure, pleasure, pressure, exposure, enclosure, closure, disclosure, composure Addition and subtraction: This week we have been starting with 3-digit numbers and then adding and subtracting first ones and then tens. We have been crossing the tens so have also had to exchange using either base 10, our own drawings of fish (hundreds), chips (tens) and peas (ones) or number lines and partitioning. **RE** - We continued to learn about the story of Abraham and then discussed how Christians today use this story to help them live as God intended. We answered the question: what difference does being a Christian make to daily life? MUSIC - We practiced the note A and semibreves (4 beat notes) alongside crochets (1 Other Curriculum Areas beat notes) and minims (2 beat notes). Then we practiced playing pieces using both notes A and B. Science - We had 2 lessons this week and investigated why do we get shadows and how do we stay safe in the sun? PE- Basketball - we developed our team working skills and learnt how to attack and defend. Computing - we learnt about a network server and a wireless access point and how they help us access work in school. **Spanish** - we learnt how to ask how old someone is and how to respond with our own age. **Topic** - We discussed the question - what was life like in the bronze age? We had a fabulous morning on Wednesday celebrating European Day of Languages: we tasted new foods, learnt Salsa dancing and produced some art work.
