Maths	Addition and subtraction: This week we have been subtracting first ones and then tens. We have been crossing the tens so have also had to exchange using either base 10/place value counters or our own drawings of fish (hundreds), chips (tens) and peas (ones). Which number sentence is incorrect? 5 + 7 = 12 120 = 50 + 70 12 ones - 7 ones = 5 ones 50 - 70 = 120 12 - 5 = 7 12 tens - 5 tens = 7 tens Write the correct sentence.  What mistake has Tinu made?
