


# Robins class (y3)

	Friday 14 <sup>th</sup> November 2025: This week we have been...
English	<p>Using the book 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura we have written a diary entry from the perspective of the boy who is new to the Stone Age. We have also written a setting description of the cave and cave paintings. We have used expanded noun phrases and figurative language to paint the picture for the reader.</p> <p>Our spellings this week have all been year 3 challenge words: Actual, answer, bicycle, circle, earth, enough, fruit, island, often, popular.</p>
Maths	<p><b>Multiplication and division:</b></p> <p>This week we have started a new topic of multiplication and division. We have been revising what we know about equal groups, arrays and multiples of 2.</p> <p>How many different arrays can you make with 12 counters?</p> 
Other Curriculum Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>RE</b> - After discussing the art work we looked at last week, we drew our own representations of the story of Jesus' baptism trying to share the meaning of the Trinity with Christians.</li> <li>• <b>Topic</b> - We learnt about what life was like in the stone age</li> <li>• <b>Computing</b> - we created a stop frame animation of a simple stick figure and used the onion skinning feature so we could see our previous frame whilst drawing our changed figure.</li> <li>• <b>Music</b> - We learnt how to play the note E and listened to the minimalist piece 'Short Ride on a Fast Machine' by John Adams.</li> <li>• <b>Art</b> - We used the cross hatching technique to create shade on an anatomy drawing of a woolly mammoth.</li> <li>• <b>DT</b> - We continued to work on our sewing project.</li> <li>• <b>PE</b> - In football we worked on our passing skills and in gymnastics we worked on key shapes using tension for balance and then incorporated these into a travelling sequence.</li> </ul>
