


We also designed our own planets. • Topic - We learnt about what Stonehenge is. • Computing - We designed storyboards for our own stop motion animation. • Music - We started to learn to play and sing 'Got the E B G Bs'. • Art - we created different shades and tones of brown using powder and poster paint and used this to create cave painting hand prints. • PE - in gymnastics we worked on some travelling routines which included patch and point balances and jumps.
