English	<p>We finished and edited our own versions of the story 'Into the Forest' by Anthony Browne. Then we moved onto a new book called 'Pebble in My Pocket' by Meredith Hooper and Chris Coady. It's a fabulous book with lots of information about the formation and journey pf a pebble through the history of Earth. We have read a few pages and have moved in time from 480 million years ago to 300 million years ago. We have been learning about cause and effect on the pebbles journey and we then learnt about Causal conjunctions and how to use them both at the start and in the middle of sentences. Eg. Wind, rain and sun beat down on the rocks consequently they become much smoother. Or the rocks become much smoother as a result of the wind, rain and sun beating down on them.</p> <p>Our spellings this week have all included the digraph 'ai' and the tetraphraph 'aigh': Straight, painter, fainted, waist, strainer, chained, claimed, failure, snail, waiter</p>
Maths	<p><b>Length and Perimeter:</b></p> <p>We started a new topic this week looking at length and perimeter. Using Scratch we first of all learnt how to programme a sprite to perform a sequence of moves and choosing how we wanted to start that sequence with an event key.
