


Robins class (y3)

	Friday 27 th February 2026: This week we have been...
English	<p>We are using the book 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit this term for our writing. The book is written from the point of view of a boy called Tranio and we have focused on the first few pages of the book this week which describe Pompeii just before the Vesuvius erupted. We have written expanded noun phrases and learnt about fronted adverbials before putting that all together in a description of Pompeii city, life and Vesuvius.</p> <p>Our spellings this week have all ended with the suffix 'ly': calmly, exactly, deadly, bravely, boldly, gladly, deeply, clearly, hourly, quickly</p>
Maths	<p>Fractions:</p> <p>This week we have been learning about denominators and numerators in fractions. We have learnt that when the numerator and denominator are the same then that equals a whole. Then, we finished the week comparing and ordering non-unit fractions.</p>  <p>Write the fractions in order, starting with the smallest fraction.</p> <p>Whitney and Eva are looking at this bar model.</p> <p>Whitney: This is $\frac{4}{4}$</p> <p>Eva: This is 1 whole.</p> <p>Explain your answer. Who do you agree with?</p> <p>Next week, we will cover fractions and scales before using a number line and bar models to compare equivalent fractions.</p>
