



Robins class (y3)

	Friday 6 th March 2026: This week we have been...
English	<p>Using the book 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit we have continued to think about vocabulary and focusing on making the right verb/adjective choice to create mood through our writing. The story has moved on this week to the actual eruption of the volcano so we have focused on recognising and writing phrases to describe this. We have also focused on how using our 5 senses in our writing can improve description.</p> <p>For both this week and next week our spellings have all been homophones: grate, great, groan, grown, main, mane, meat, meet, missed, mist</p>
Maths	<p>Fractions:</p> <p>This week we have been placing and counting fractions on a number line and looking at equivalent fractions.</p> <div data-bbox="256 611 550 629" style="font-size: small;"> <p>Tiny is labelling fractions on a number line from 0 to 1</p> </div>  <p>Use the bar models to find the equivalent fractions.</p>  $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{\square}{6} = \frac{6}{\square} = \frac{\square}{\square}$ <p>What mistake has Tiny made? What should the labels be?</p> <p>Next week, we will move onto a new topic: measuring mass and capacity. We will start this by measuring in grams and kilograms and looking at equivalent weights (grams and kilograms)</p>
