	Friday 13 th March 2026: This week we have been...
English	<p>Using the book 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit we have continued to think about vocabulary and writing figuratively. We have been writing similes and metaphors about Vesuvius and have also looked at how we can use a simile to start a sentence. We then moved on to planning our own version of an eye witness account of the eruption of Vesuvius. We have focused our planning on formulating our ideas into paragraphs and drafting sentences within those paragraphs using the many different ways to start a sentence that we have been learning about: fronted adverbial, powerful verbs, similes.</p> <p>We also complete a reading booklet.</p> <p>For both this week and last week our spellings have all been homophones: grate, great, groan, grown, main, mane, meat, meet, missed, mist</p>
Maths	<p>Measuring mass:</p> <p>This week we have been learning how to measure mass in grams and kilograms using different scales.</p> <p>Here are some balance scales.</p>  <p>Work out the mass of the sphere.</p> <p>We also completed a maths booklet.</p> <p>Next week we will look at equivalent masses, compare masses and add and subtract masses before moving onto volume and capacity.</p>
