English	<p>At the start of the week we learnt about using the past tense in our writing and then using the book 'A Gift from Winklesea' by Helen Cresswell we planned and wrote a descriptive paragraph about the animal that we imagined might hatch from the egg. On World Book Day we participated in a webinar with Born Free and Michael Morpergo where we learnt about endangered animals and lions in particular. Maths	<p>Fractions:</p> <p>We completed lots of work on equivalent fractions using both number lines and bar models.</p> <p>Draw number lines to complete the equivalent fractions.</p> <p> $\triangleright \frac{\square}{4} = \frac{2}{8}$ $\triangleright \frac{2}{4} = \frac{\square}{8}$ $\triangleright \frac{\square}{\square} = \frac{6}{8}$ $\triangleright \frac{4}{4} = \frac{\square}{\square} = 1$ </p> <p>On World Book Day we completed a maths investigation to solve a code to help some book characters find their way out of the woods.</p>
