	Friday 20 th March 2026: This week we have been...
English	<p>Continuing with our book 'Escape from Pompeii', we began the week by writing our eye witness accounts. We focused on using first person narrative and the past tense and using different sentence starters such as fronted adverbials and similes. At the end of the week we moved on to learning more about what happened after the eruption and how, over many years, Pompeii is being excavated to teach us about life back then.</p> <p>Our spellings this week have all been challenge words: build, describe, imagine, library, natural, ordinary, promise, recent, suppose, weight.</p>
Maths	<p>Measure mass:</p> <p>This week we finished our mass topic by looking at equivalent mass, comparing masses and adding and subtracting mass. We then revised some problem solving using our knowledge on place value, number facts and addition and subtraction.</p> <div data-bbox="245 672 925 963"> </div> <p>Next week we will be moving onto capacity and volume, so looking at millilitres and litres, comparing capacity and volume and adding and subtracting capacity and volume.</p>
