

Maths	<p>Mass and Capacity:</p> <p>We have finished our topic on mass and capacity by adding and subtracting different weights and solving word problems.</p> <p>Here are some measuring cylinders.</p>  <p>The total liquid in all three cylinders is 400 ml.</p> <p>Cylinder X has half of the total amount in it.</p> <p>Cylinder Y has 67 ml less than cylinder X.</p> <p>How much liquid does each cylinder contain?</p>

We then put this into practice using dinosaur top trump cards to make our own branching database. • Topic - we discussed what life was like in Roman Britain. • Dance workshop - we participated in a dance workshop with 2 dancers from New Adventures dance company where we learnt some of the choreography from Matthew Bourne's ballet 'The Red Shoes'. We also used some of his choreographic techniques, of using every day movement and gestures, to improvise and create our own moves. • We have also spent some time rehearsing for our Easter service.
