Friday 3rd May 2024: This week we have been... This week we learnt about using the present tense. Then we moved onto using the book 'Jim and the Beanstalk' by Raymond Briggs. We discussed our understanding of the story and wrote some speech using inverted commas. At the end of the week, we continued to use the book 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpergo. We deigned and wrote a persuasive poster for a circus. Our spellings have all had the suffix 'er' - teacher, stretcher, dispatcher, catcher, butcher, richer, scorcher, preacher, cruncher, watcher. Money: This week we have revised our knowledge of money and extended this using much larger amounts than we looked at last year. We have been solving equations through adding and subtracting. We have also been learning about exchanging notes for coins to make these equations easier. Teddy buys a sticker book and a football. He pays with a £10 note. A sticker book costs £4 and 60p. A football costs £3 and 45p. How much change does he get? PE - Rounders - we practiced running at speed to get around all of the bases and then we played some mini games where the batter had to try and get around all of the bases before the fielders got the ball back to the bowler.
