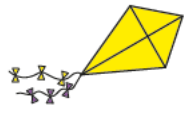


Robins class (y3)

	Friday 19 th June 2026: This week we have been...
English	We started the week by editing our own versions of Jim and the Beanstalk and then we planned a recount of our trip to Canterbury Cathedral. We focused on using the present perfect tense so discussed how we could start some sentences with: 'I have had...' 'I have been...' We also reflected on our year in Robins and started to plan what and how we will write up our reflections. Our spellings this week have all been words ending in '-gue' and '-que': vague, league, plague, fatigue, antique, unique, grotesque, mosque, plaque, dialogue
Maths	Shape: This week we have been learning about, comparing and drawing angles and lines. We have learnt about obtuse and acute angles and horizontal and vertical lines. Label the acute and obtuse angles in these pictures. Draw and label horizontal and/or vertical lines of symmetry on the shapes.
