English	This week, we have written and edited our recounts of our trip to Canterbury Cathedral and we have written and illustrated our reflections of our year in Robins. We also completed a reading booklet. Our spellings this week have all been words where the digraph 'sc' makes a /s/ sound: Science, scene, discipline, fascinate, crescent, scissors, ascend, scented, scenery, descend
Maths	Shape: We have completed our shape topic with 2D and 3D shapes. We have been discussing vertices, sides, edges and faces in order to distinguish between the shapes and have been drawing and building them: Take six cubes. How many different cuboids can you make? Draw your cuboids. We have also completed a maths booklet.
