What does my child need each day?

- **Packed lunch / school dinner ordered**
- **Coat** (we will go outside every day, even if it is raining)
- **Water bottle**
- **Snack** (fruit or vegetables)
- **Reading book and reading record** (this can be a school library book)
- **Wellies** or change of shoes (these can be stored in school)

To protect clothes you may want to send an old shirt or **overall for Art** – this could be stored in a bag in their locker.

- **Headphones** to keep in their tray or a box in the cupboard and use when we are listening to or creating music or audio on the laptops or iPads (these do not need to be fancy, but it is really helpful for them to be labelled with their name)

No resources are needed – all pens and pencils, rulers etc are provided by school. However, if they do want to bring pencil cases in, these need to fit in their drawer, or go home each night. Thank you.

- **Settled in to KS2 now** - we will support them in being increasingly independent
- **Busy curriculum** – see **weekly overviews** for key learning, events and notices
- **Help** by being organised and on time
- **Reading** is key: the most important thing we can do in school and at home! Hear them read and read to them, taking the opportunity to enjoy and discuss new vocabulary. Support us in keeping your reading record up to date and celebrating their achievement of house points.
- **Maths Homework – Numbots** for September please. Number bonds are very important and can get neglected with the focus on times tables. We will renew efforts with tables facts once we begin our multiplication topic in October. TTRockstars will then be used weekly in school. Times tables will initially be revising 2,5,10,3,4,8x and then starting on 6,9,7,11 and 12x! Y4 **National Multiplication Tables Check** week is June 2nd – 6th 2024 - please don't book holidays! Some **MyMaths** homeworks will be set throughout the year – they will really help consolidate learning.
- **Cornet lessons** - 20 free 'Music Plus' lessons with Stefan Hughes on Monday afternoons - please embrace this opportunity!
- **Online logins** for Seesaw, Mymaths, TTRockstars and Spelling Shed sent out
- **Communications** – we have the school office, website, Seesaw, email and parent text system
- **Issues** – contact **teacher first** via office, or email
- **PE kits** Tuesday and Thursday, **swimming** Tuesday. No earrings to be worn.
- **Name** uniform and sports kits fully please. New blue T-shirt optional.
- **Behaviour** – good behaviour is rewarded. I will contact you if we have any problems.
- **Healthy** lunchboxes. Water and a fruit/veg snack please.
- **Illness** – let us know, extra caution for Covid symptoms
- **Inform us** if your child is being collected by someone else / going to BASC / club
