## Final Details about Puffins Class Trip to Samphire Hoe

Our class trip to **Samphire Hoe**, is next week on **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024**. This visit will link with our Geography studies of Kent Downland and our science work on animal and plant habitats.

Due to the time of the visit, your child needs to be dropped off at school at **8:20am**. We will be back to school for the normal pick up time.

Children will be able to wear their **own clothes**. They should wear flat trainers or walking shoes, have a sun-hat and should bring with them all clothing necessary for any weather on the day (at least one extra layer and a rain jacket if any chance of rain). The rangers advise that it can be cold and windy 'down on the Hoe'.

They will all need a substantial **packed lunch** (no nuts or chocolate please) and a water bottle (these can be re-filled there).
