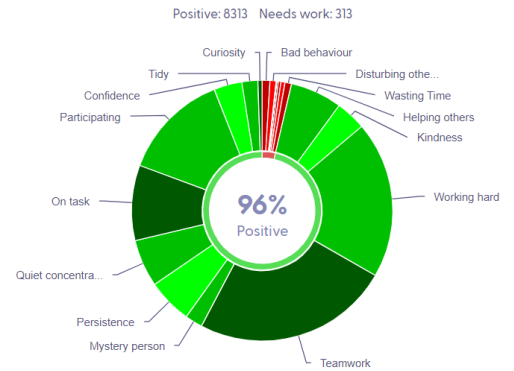


Puffins Weekly Overview
