Last week we were able to let you know your child's class teacher for next year. We are excited to now share with you our plans for our teaching assistant team.

We are really pleased that, despite reductions in school budgets, we will continue to be able to provide full-time teaching assistant support for each class.

In addition, the children will be benefitting from 3 new provisions aimed to ensure that all our pupils, including those with Special Educational Needs, are able to access a curriculum pathway that is suitable for them. These will be:

- Academic tutors two of our teaching assistants will deliver learning interventions that will help many children across the school with Speech and Language, Reading, Writing and Maths.
- 'The Nest' a play-based curriculum for younger pupils who benefit from learning in a quieter space with a nurture approach.
- 'Woodpeckers' a nurture curriculum for older pupils who may find the busy classroom overwhelming at times and find it helpful to work in a smaller group.
