



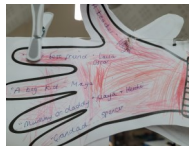
This week's News

Owls did some drama scenarios and writing.



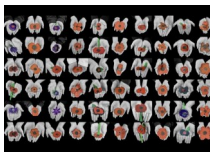
Puffins sang a song called 'Individuality' and talked about what respect means.
