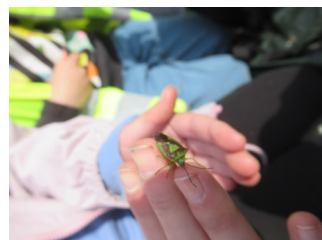




This Week's News
