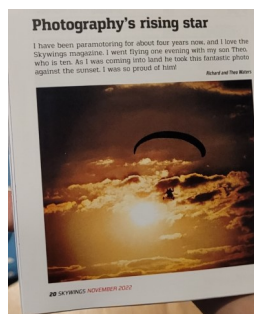
Over the last couple of weeks, KS2 children have taken part in the Bebras Challenge. This challenge is organised in 50 different countries around the world with
