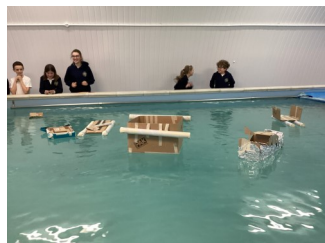




This week's News
