And to finish off, we have Caleb in Yr4 who at the weekend is going to a golf competition. Good luck Caleb, and we'll let you know how he got on next week.

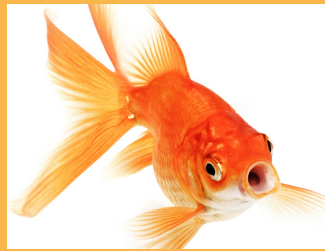
That's sadly all we have time for this week, but we have room for next week - so let us know about your celebrations!

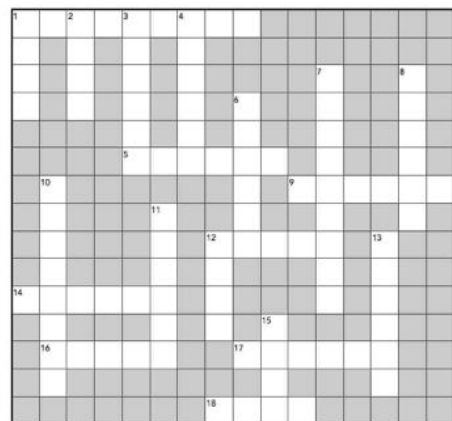
The pond is looking lovely at the moment. How many fish can you spot in there?

## Tricky Words Crossword

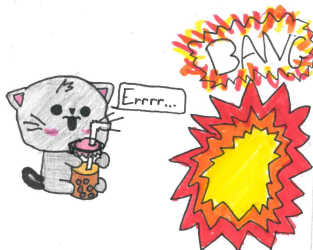


### Across
